JUNIOR NATIONAL TOURN.- JULY 18- 26 FARGO,N.D

**This year the camp will be held in River Falls.**

**Fargo:Greco - Report Tue-July 15<sup>th</sup> 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.-Super 8 Motel -River Falls .Camp ends Friday, July 18 Team leaves Saturday, July 19<sup>th</sup>.**

**Fargo: Freestyle-Report Sat.-July 19<sup>th</sup> 10:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m. Super 8 Motel -River Falls .Camp ends Tuesday, July 22<sup>rd</sup>-Team leaves Wed. July 23<sup>rd</sup>.**

**Greco Team**- There are two or four spots available. The only spot that is guaranteed is that of the champion at that weight in the State Greco Tournament held at Fond du Lac April 19<sup>th</sup> . The other two or three spots will be determined at camp.

**Freestyle Team**- There are two or four spots available. The only spot that is guaranteed is that of the champion at that weight in the State Freestyle Tournament held at Wisconsin Rapids on April 26<sup>th</sup> .The other spots will be determined at camp.

Only the champion at the state freestyle/greco meet is guaranteed a spot for Fargo and it is at the weight that he won it. **In addition, if you place in the top three at the Northern Plains held at Waterloo Ia, on May 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> you also qualify and do not count against our allotment for Fargo -but you still must attend the camp.** The Wisconsin Team has two divisions and only one spot is guaranteed. If you really want to be guaranteed a spot on both the freestyle and greco teams then you should have placed in both styles at the Northern Plains Regional held in Waterloo, Ia. and you should have won both styles at the state tournaments. Other than doing both of these things, it cannot be guaranteed that you will be able to wrestle in both styles Fargo .The final decision will be made by the coaches at camp.

**Cost:** The camp itself is **\$275**. If you make the team to Fargo, additional costs will be: **\$50 per style** to cover transportation, housing and an entry fee, and **\$175** for the uniform package. If you have already purchased one for this year, you will not need to purchase it again.. All Wisconsin National Team Members must wear the 2008 Wisconsin Singlet and accompanying uniform at the National Tournament.

**Deposit:** We need to have a handle on predicting the number of wrestlers coming into camp and an idea of how to contact you incase that there are any last minute changes. **In order to do this we need to receive a \$50 deposit,(or a verbal confirmation) a medical contact form,and the signed code of conduct by June 1<sup>st</sup>.** This deposit should be a check made out to W.W.F.,sent along with your enclosed medical contact form . # **WISCONSIN WRESTLING FEDERATION TEAM PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT**

## **Philosophy**

The Wisconsin Wrestling Federation knows that the sport of wrestling can be a constructive force in the lives of our youth. The Federation is committed to providing participants in its activities with a variety of opportunities to build personal character, integrity, respect, responsibility and other skills necessary for them to reach their potential as citizens. While involvement in these activities is voluntary, it is also a privilege and athletes choosing to participate, take on extended responsibilities as special representatives of their state and wrestling community. These responsibilities hold the athlete to a high standard of conduct as a condition of participation and will help make participation in our programs a stronger learning experience.

## **Purpose**

The purpose of this code is to define the rules for athletes participating on Wisconsin Wrestling Federation teams and to define the consequences for those individuals who violate these rules. Participants involved in Federation programs are expected to comply with these regulations, observe good order, and conduct themselves in a manner that will bring credit and honor to them and their state. All parties involved must always consider both the best interests of the individual and the integrity of the Wisconsin Wrestling Federation.

## **Athletes Code of Conduct**

### **CATEGORY I**

Athletes qualifying for or being selected to Wisconsin Wrestling Federation teams are expected to abide by the laws of the city, State or Country in which the travel/competition/training is taking place and must:

1. Abstain from **ALL** illegal activity including the use of alcohol, tobacco and the use of illegal drugs.
2. Abstain from sexual activities and/or sexual abuse.
3. Refrain from theft or vandalism of any property, hotel rooms, dormitories, training facilities, and equipment.

Any person subject to the terms and conditions of the code of conduct who violates **CATEGORY I** provisions shall:

- Be sent home at the expense of the athlete and their family.
- Reimburse the Wisconsin Wrestling Federation directly for any damages resulting from illegal activities.
- Be banned from participating in any Wisconsin Wrestling Federation or USA Wrestling event for the remainder of the USA Wrestling sanctioned season.
- Be reported to the authorities.

**CATEGORY II**

Athletes qualifying for or being selected to Wisconsin Wrestling Federation teams must:

1. Refrain from using profane, insulting, harassing or otherwise offensive language.
2. Follow the rules of the Organizing Committee of the competition/activity.
3. Address fellow athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, event organizers, spectators and others associated with the events in a courteous and respectful manner.
4. Abide by bed check and quiet hours designated by team coaches/leaders and remain in their assigned room unless granted permission to leave by a team coach/leader.
5. Meet at team assembly points on time and attend all team meetings.
6. Compete in the Wisconsin Wrestling Federation team uniform provided.

Any person subject to the terms and conditions of the code of conduct who violates **CATEGORY II** provisions is subject to the following:

Violation One: Coaches/leaders will assign punishment to suit the offense.

Violation Two: Coaches/leaders will assign punishment to suit the offense and parents will be notified.

Violation Three: Same as **CATEGORY I** consequences.

Your signature, as an athlete, on this form indicates that you understand and agree to abide by the Code of Conduct and philosophy. Your signature, as a parent/guardian, means that you have read and understand the possible penalties and enforcement of a violation. Any infractions hereafter will be considered a violation of the athletic code.
